Since he was just two months old, Jason has been battling Cystic Fibrosis (CF), a genetic disorder disease of the secretory glands, including those that make mucus and sweat. The disease promotes thick mucus build-up in various areas such as the lungs

and digestive tract, leaving Jason prone to infection. His current treatment consists of bi-weekly visits to the CF Team at CHOC Children's Hospital to monitor the effects of the disease on his system, ensuring that there are no other complications.

Jason is one of six children. Recently, his parents have fallen behind with payments as a result of missed work in order to care for Jason. Normally they are able to make ends meet, but the family has overspent on transportation costs to get to and from the hospital several times a day. The costs of providing for the other five children, including unplanned food at the hospital and home, have become increasingly difficult. The unplanned expenses have taken a devastating toll on the family. Barely surviving month to month, the Luna family is unable to keep up with bills, general and medical, on top of their mortgage payments. They reached out to Miracles for Kids for aid and, thanks to supporters like you, were granted monthly financial assistance through the Miracles for Kids Grant Program to help with rent. The assistance helps alleviate financial strain, allowing the family to concentrate on the care for Jason.
