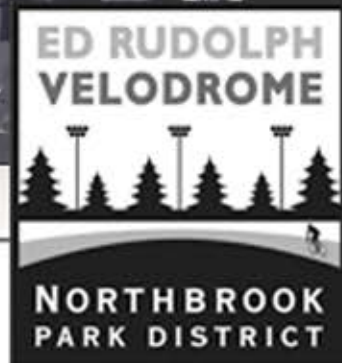


# GEORGE GARNER

- 1939** Begins bicycle racing in the state of California
- 1947** Opens his first bicycle store in California after serving as a Marine in WWII
- 1953** Founding member and developer of the Encino Velodrome in Encino, CA
- 1965** Moves to Illinois and opens a location in Northbrook while working as a consultant for the Schwinn Bicycle Company. This location would be used to showcase his Total Concept Store model for dealers nationwide.
- 1984** Inducted into the Northbrook Park District Hall of Fame
- 1985** Helps to secure funds necessary to resurface, restore and maintain the Ed Rudolph Velodrome
- 1989** Receives the Community Service Award from the Illinois Park and Recreation Association and the Illinois Association of Park Districts
- 1991** Awarded Honorary Membership by the Illinois Cycling Association for years of dedicated service
- 2002** Major contributor to the restoration of the Encino Velodrome in Encino, CA
- 2004** Major contributor to the resurfacing and restoration of the Ed Rudolph Velodrome
- 2012** Recognized by the State of Illinois House of Representatives 97th General Assembly for his lifelong Service and Dedication to the sport of cycling in the state of Illinois
