Defendant Strava, Inc. ("Defendant" or "Strava") operates a social networking website geared towards athletes. Athletes of all abilities sign up for a free or paid membership and thereafter have access to sign up for events hosted by Strava or share with other users their own workouts. A significant number of www.strava.com users are cyclists. Strava encourages the sport of cycling by creating, hosting, facilitating, promoting, and giving rewards for competitive races, including the "King of the Mountain (KOM)" challenge. The KOM challenge is an open-ended race. Those cyclists who want to sign up for the KOM challenge purchase Global Positioning System (GPS) monitors to submit accurate times and distances. The times are then posted onto Strava's website. Cyclists are encouraged to "tear it up" on the road. Strava has received increased notoriety in the sporting world due to the fast times posted to their website.

(description of reasons for liability):

On June 19, 2010, William K. Flint, II ("Kim Flint Jr.), went out to a KOM challenge in Tilden Park, Orinda, CA. Kim Flint Jr. had previously posted the fastest KOM time, which was later beaten. Kim Flint Jr. went out the very next day after learning that he no longer had the fastest KOM time to regain his title. In pursuit of regaining his title, Kim Flint Jr. came in contact with an automobile and was killed.

Defendant Strava owed the deceased, Kim Flint Jr., a duty of care to use the degree of care that a reasonable person in the same situation would have used to protect their users from danger. Defendant breached their duty of care by: (1) failing to warn cyclists competing in KOM challenge that the road conditions were not suited for racing and that it was unreasonably dangerous given those conditions; (2) failing to take adequate measures to ensure the KOM challenges took place on safe courses, and (3) encouraging dangerous behavior. It was foreseeable that the failure to warn of dangerous conditions, take safety measures, and encourage dangerous behavior would cause Kim Flint Jr. to die since Kim Flint Jr. justifiably relied on Defendant to host a safe challenge. Had Defendant done the aforementioned acts, Kim Flint Jr. would not have died as he did.

Kim Flint Jr. lost his life due to Defendant's negligence in failing to host a safe competition. Plaintiffs, his surviving parents and intestate heirs, seek compensatory damages for Defendant's negligence.
