Re: Request for Inclusion of Certain Aluminum Derivative Production in the Section 232 Measures on Aluminum (AMENDED)

Dear Secretary Lutnick:

On behalf of the Aluminum Extruders Council ("AEC"), we hereby request that the Bureau of Industry and Security, U.S. Department of Commerce (the "Department") adjust the Section 232 tariffs on aluminum to include the derivative aluminum products identified at **Exhibit 1**. As discussed in detail below, imports of these derivative aluminum products are entering the United States in such quantities and under such circumstances so as to threaten to impair U.S. national security. Consequently, the existing Section 232 measures should be adjusted to include imports of these products as derivatives subject to Section 232 relief. Such action is necessary to address the threat that these imports pose to national security and to maintain the integrity of the Section 232 aluminum program. This request is timely submitted pursuant to the Department's September 17, 2025, Federal Register notice ("Sep. 17 Notice"). ¹

I. INTRODUCTION

By way of background, the AEC is an international trade association dedicated to advancing the effective use of aluminum extrusion in North America. Aluminum extrusions are produced by forcing cylindrical aluminum billets, made out of a combination of primary and secondary aluminum, through presses that create shapes out of the aluminum. The AEC represents well over 50% of all aluminum extrusion production in the United States.

II. <u>ADDITIONAL DERIVATIVE PRODUCTS SHOULD BE SUBJECT TO SECTION 232 COVERAGE</u>

A. Aluminum Derivative Articles for Inclusion in Section 232 Coverage

The AEC requests that the Department add the derivative aluminum products in **Exhibit 1** to its list of products subject to Section 232 aluminum tariffs. **Exhibit 1** identifies both the U.S. Harmonized Tariff Schedule ("HTS") codes and product descriptions for each item. These derivative aluminum products consist of aluminum-intensive downstream products, including solar mounts and frames, highway signage, and furniture, all of which are critical customer segments for domestic aluminum extruders. The aluminum derivative articles on this list are largely comprised of aluminum and contain a significant percentage of aluminum as measured by weight and/or cost, with the precise amount varying by product. In short, each of the derivatives listed in **Exhibit 1** contains a significant percentage of aluminum and should be considered derivative aluminum products eligible for Section 232 coverage. Any non-aluminum content would not be subject to tariffs per the Department's Proclamation.²

B. <u>U.S. Imports of Aluminum Derivative Products are Substantial and Increasing</u>

U.S. imports of the aluminum derivatives listed in **Exhibit 1** have largely increased since the imposition of the Section 232 measures in 2018, as measured by volume.³ In terms of value, U.S. imports of these derivative products increased by more than 60% between the 2015-2017 annual average (the three-year period before the Section 232 measures were put in place) and 2024. Indeed, several aluminum derivatives experiencing double and triple-digit growth in value during the period, including the following:

- HTS 39249056: Household articles and toilet articles, nesoi, of plastics (up 40.01%)
- HTS 39252000: Doors, windows, and their frames and thresholds for doors, of plastics (up 195.83%)
- HTS 63061200: Tarpaulins, awnings and sunblinds, of synthetic fibers (up 242.15%)
- HTS 73089060: Iron or steel, columns, pillars, posts, beams and girders, nesoi (up 133.22%)
- HTS 7308909590: Structures, parts of structures and articles prepared for use in structures, nesoi, of iron or steel (up 137.51%)

- HTS 83100000: Base metal sign plates, name plates, address plates, numbers, letters and other symbols (o/than of 9405), and base metal parts thereof (up 51.04%)
- HTS 86069100: Railway or tramway freight cars nesoi, closed and covered, not self-propelled (up 496.14%)
- HTS 87131000: Invalid carriages, not mechanically propelled (up 52.33%)
- HTS 87162000: Self-loading or self-unloading trailers and semi-trailers, not mech. propelled, for agricultural purposes (up 140.62%)
- HTS 98170050: Machinery, equipment and implements to be used for agricultural or horticultural purposes (up 195.58%)

Import volumes are similarly up for a number of aluminum derivatives. For instance, U.S. imports of certain bicycle frames under HTS 8714912000 increased 65.75% as measured by number, in 2024 as compared to the 2015-2017 annual average. During the same comparison period, U.S. imports of trailers and semi-trailers for housing or camping under HTS 87161000 increased by 298.86% as measured by number; U.S. imports of tarpaulins, awnings and sunblinds, of synthetic fibers under HTS 63061200 increased by 639.63% as measured by kg. U.S. imports of seats nesoi, w/metal frame (o/than of heading 9402), upholstered under HTS 94017100 increased 84.20% as measured by number in 2024, while U.S. imports under HTS 87162000, which captures self-loading or self-unloading trailers and semi-trailers, not mech. propelled, for agricultural purposes, increased by 277.03% as measured by number.

In short, U.S. imports of the aluminum derivatives in **Exhibit 1** have increased significantly since the Section 232 tariffs on aluminum were imposed.

C. <u>U.S. Imports of Aluminum Derivative Products Threaten to Impair U.S. National Security</u>

Since the aluminum Section 232 tariffs were imposed in March 2018, foreign producers have exploited loopholes in the program and have increasingly moved production downstream as a means to evade the tariffs. Although the loopholes are now closed,⁴ covered aluminum products continue to be processed into downstream derivative products in order to enter the U.S. market

Prior to February 2025, the program had gradually been weakened over time through country exemptions, quotas, GAEs and millions of tons worth of importer-specific product exclusions. These loopholes facilitated large volumes of U.S. imports, particularly from tariff exempt sources and countries subject to an alternative agreement. Indeed, shortly after the initial 25% Section 232 tariffs were put in place, aluminum derivative imports began to surge into the U.S. market, prompting the President's Proclamations expanding Section 232 coverage to include several aluminum derivative products. In February 2025, these loopholes were closed, but aluminum derivative imports continued to surge into the U.S. market, prompting the expansion of Section 232 coverage to include further aluminum derivatives, first in February and most recently in August 2025. The aluminum derivatives identified in **Exhibit 1** are not currently subject to Section 232 tariffs but should be for the reasons discussed herein.

tariff free. The result has been a surge in U.S. imports of aluminum derivative products, which has necessitated the expansion of Section 232 coverage, first in January 2020⁵ and most recently on August 19, 2025. ⁶ Indeed, last month, Commerce expanded Section 232 coverage to include additional aluminum derivatives upon finding that increasing U.S. imports of these aluminum derivatives threaten to impair U.S. national security. For the reasons discussed herein, Commerce should further expand Section 232 coverage to include the aluminum derivatives in **Exhibit 1** for the same reason.

While the Section 232 program loopholes have been closed, global aluminum excess capacity remains significant and increasing, making the domestic aluminum industry particularly vulnerable to the substantial volume of aluminum derivative imports that continue to enter the U.S. market. Indeed, as the President noted in his February 2025 Proclamation, "{f} oreign producers are continuing to expand downstream production to absorb the global excess capacity," thereby harming the domestic aluminum industry and warranting the expansion of Section 232 coverage to include additional aluminum derivative products. The same is true here, prompting a further expansion of this coverage to cover the aluminum derivatives listed in **Exhibit 1**.

Increased imports of the aluminum derivatives in **Exhibit 1** have taken market share from and eroded business opportunities for both the domestic aluminum producers that supply these industries as well as those that compete directly with these imports, thereby undermining the Section 232 program. As an initial matter, domestic extruded aluminum producers produce several of the aluminum derivative products listed in **Exhibit 1**. These products include extruded aluminum clamp, extruded aluminum solar panel racking rails, tent poles/frames, and bimini tops, among many others. The health of these and other U.S. aluminum derivative industries directly impacts domestic primary and extruded aluminum demand.

Moreover, substantial volume of low-priced aluminum derivative imports in the U.S. market have forced derivative aluminum industries in the United States to purchase imports rather than domestic aluminum products, resulting in fewer sales for domestic aluminum producers. To this end, derivative industries such as machinery and household goods are critical markets for both primary aluminum and aluminum extrusions, both of which have experienced stark declines in operating and financial performance indicators since 2018.

 Per the President's February 2025 Proclamation, "[d]omestic aluminum producers have been forced to idle additional production and shut down facilities. Two primary aluminum smelters within the United States have closed since Proclamation 9704 was promulgated. In addition, U.S. primary aluminum production decreased by 30 percent from 2020 to 2024, and U.S. smelter capacity

utilization was only 52 percent in 2024." U.S. primary aluminum consumption declined roughly 18% between 2018 and 2014, 9 and by early 2024, there were only 4 aluminum smelters left in the United States. ¹⁰

• The domestic extruded aluminum industry has also suffered declines. In the same February 2025 Proclamation, President Trump notes that "overcapacity for primary aluminum has harmed downstream aluminum producers, including producers of aluminum extrusions and aluminum sheet." Indeed, between 2018 and 2024, domestic shipments and apparent domestic consumption declined 19% and 14%, respectively.¹¹

These data confirm that the domestic aluminum industry has been harmed by and remains vulnerable to the adverse effects of increasing aluminum derivative imports. This underscores the need to expand section 232 coverage to include the aluminum derivatives at **Exhibit 1**.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Section 232 coverage should be expanded to include the aluminum derivatives listed in **Exhibit 1**. U.S. imports of these derivatives have increased significantly since the imposition of Section 232 measures on aluminum, harming domestic aluminum producers and undermining the Section 232 program.
