

IMPORTANT RECALL NOTICE

What is the problem?

The rigid front forks on these recalled bikes can bend or break during use or while jumping, causing the rider to lose control, posing fall and crash hazards to the user.

How to Identify the affected bikes?

2016 “Pine Mountain 1” and 2017 “Pine Mountain” bicycles were sold in five frame sizes and in one basic color scheme (silver painted frame with orange painted fork.) The model name “Pine Mountain 1” (2016) or “Pine Mountain” (2017) is printed on the top tube of the frame and the downtube of the frame has a “MARIN” decal.

Remedy: Repair

Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled bicycle contact Marin Mountain Bikes at **(800) 222-7557** from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. PT Monday through Friday, or visit the firm’s website at www.marinbikes.com and click on “Recalls / Safety” at the bottom of the page for more information.



Marin authorized retailers will replace the affected fork (free of charge). The recalled vs replacement forks are identified in the photo to the left. No other part of the bicycles are affected. We sincerely apologize for the inconvenience and thank you for your cooperation in this important safety program. This recall is being conducted in cooperation with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission and Health Canada.
